FIXED PRICE SALES AGREEMENT

This is an agreement between Todd Porter, consignee (Antique American Clocks, LLC) and _____, consignor, to list one or more clocks belonging to the consignor for sale on the AACClocks website (<https://aaclocks.com/>).

Clocks listed for sale must have an **anticipated retail value of \$5000 or greater**, as determined by Antique American Clocks (AAC).

Up to two clocks can be concurrently listed for sale individually at an agreed-upon price, *not less than \$5000 each*; the duration of the listing will be **one month**. During this time Antique American Clocks will promote their sale by:

- 📧 Sending one or more **emails** to Antique American Clocks email subscribers (>1400), with pictures and links to the website.
- 📧 Posting the sale on the Antique American Clocks **Facebook group page** (>3000 members).
- 📧 Listing the clock(s) on **Facebook Marketplace** with Meta **Boost advertising** across Facebook and Instagram platforms *at no charge*.
- 📧 Listing the clock(s) on **eBay** at a **Buy It Now** price 15% higher than the AACClocks listing, to cover eBay seller expenses. eBay advertisements will include a link to the AACClocks website, and eBay is viewed primarily as an advertising venue.

The consignor has the *option* of additional national exposure through **print media advertising**, with options to advertise in *NAWCC Watch & Clock Bulletin, Maine Antique Digest, Antiques & The Arts Weekly, and AntiqueWeek*. The cost of print advertising is determined by the size of the ad and the number of placements; AACClocks will provide information and recommendations on advertising and costs and will design advertisements in consultation with the consignor. Examples of previous print ads can be provided if requested.

The fee for these services is **15% of the sale price**; print media advertising costs are borne by the consignor and will be deducted from the final payment. Note that AAC *does not charge the buyer a fee*, facilitating higher sale prices and a better return to the consignor.

Antique American Clocks will be responsible for collecting payment and delivering or shipping the clock to the purchaser. The delivery fee will not exceed \$250, will be borne by the buyer, and noted in the listing and advertisements; if desired, the consignor can ask that the fee be included in the listing price such that *free delivery* is offered to residents of the eastern half of the US (discounted delivery/transport to the western US can also be offered). With the *free delivery* option, the amount charged to the consignor will be the actual delivery expenses up to, but not to exceed, \$250.

Antique American Clocks **must take possession** of the clocks prior to listing for photography and evaluation. There is no charge to pick up clocks less than a day's drive from Lexington, KY; there will be a \$250 charge to pick up clocks located outside this driving range. For clocks located in the western US, the consignor will be responsible for getting the clock(s) to Lexington.

Should a clock not sell in the one-month time-frame, the consignor will have the option of listing the clock in an upcoming AAC auction at a 25% lower price, or having it returned. The charges for returning a clock will be as described for pick up. When return is requested, the clock will be delivered within four months of the delisting date.

Antique American Clocks will be responsible for all clocks consigned and accepted for sale once in possession and until sold or returned to the consignor; in the event of loss or damage each clock will be valued at its agreed-upon sale price.

Should a clock be returned by the purchaser for any reason, as allowed by Antique American Clocks and within the 30-day time limit, the clock will be considered unsold and Antique American Clocks will retain the right to reimbursement from the consignor for any payment made to the consignor for the clock, in exchange for the returned clock.

Antique American Clocks will be solely responsible for the descriptions and veracity of these descriptions for clocks hereby consigned to Antique American Clocks.
